



TERRY HALLMAN SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Terry Hallman Scholarship is awarded annually in memory of Terry Hallman to honour his valuable contribution to the Ontario Municipal Human Resource Association (OMHRA). Terry served as Administrative Officer from 1993 until his death in March of 2003, and was active in our Association from the time of his appointment as Personnel Director for the City of Waterloo in 1973.

Terry volunteered for many other professional associations, primarily in the Human Resources field. He was a strong believer in community involvement, serving in various capacities with many community organizations over the years.

OMHRA's Board of Directors created the Terry Hallman Scholarship, to honour Terry's numerous contributions to the profession of municipal Human Resource management.

Scholarship details:

In recognition of our 60th Anniversary, OMHRA will award two (2) scholarships with a value of \$3,000 each to two students enrolled in a full-time in and Ontario University or College degree program with an emphasis on Human Resources Management or Industrial Relations. In recognition of Terry Hallman's community involvement, applicants must also demonstrate their leadership skills and passion for community involvement.

In order to be eligible for this scholarship, applicants must be recommended by a current member of OMHRA who has been in good standing with our Association for a minimum of one (1) year.

Applications for the 2023 Scholarship must be completed as outlined below and returned by 4:00 pm EST on Friday, June 30, 2023. We regret that late applications will not be considered.

Application Instructions:

- Complete the attached application in full;
- Complete Declaration and Signature form;
- Attach a copy of your most recent final grade marks;

- Attach your confirmation of full-time registration at a Community College or University with emphasis on HR Management or Industrial Relations;
- Attach a letter of recommendation from current OMHRA member;
- Submit an essay of no more than 1,200 words describing what leadership means to you; and,
- Attach a resume that contains the following information:
 - Community Involvement/Volunteer Work
 - Work History.

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of OMHRA President, Lori Bolton, OMHRA Past President Louise Ann Riddell and OMHRA Director, Tracey McKenna. Applicants may not contact committee members directly during the application and/or review process. Questions about the application process are to be directed to customerservice@omhra.ca.

The Scholarship Committee will review your application, conduct interviews during the week of July 10, 2023, and the winning candidates will be advised shortly thereafter.

Scholarship winners will be announced during the 2023 Fall Conference and Annual General Meeting taking place September 12 to 14, 2023.
